

Selectmen's Meeting – March 15, 2004

Dr. Bowcock motioned to approve the minutes of March 1, 2004. Mr. Silvia seconded. Vote was unanimous.

F & J AUTO SALES

A hearing for F & J Auto Sales, 138 Green Street, was scheduled for 12:00 noon. As required by Massachusetts General Law, a \$25,000. bond must be posted as one of the requirements to obtain a Class II Used Car License. The bond was due January 1, 2004. To date, a bond has not been submitted. Notice of the hearing was sent by certified mail and regular mail. No one appeared on behalf of F & J Auto. Dr. Bowcock motioned to revoke the Class II Auto License, pending the securing of a \$25,000. bond, as required by Massachusetts General Law, Chapter 140, sections 57-69 inclusive. Mr. Silvia seconded. Vote was unanimous.

OTHER MATTERS

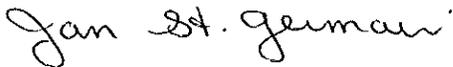
The Board offered their condolences to Jeffrey Osuch, his family and friends. His Father passed away on Thursday.
