

Selectmen's Meeting – September 28, 2004

Dr. Bowcock called the meeting to order at 12:00 noon.

TAX RATE

Mr. Silvia motioned to ratify the Board of Selectmen's vote of September 20, 2004 to set the Residential Tax Rate at \$8.35 and the Commercial Tax Rate at \$16.66. Mr. Eckenreiter seconded. Vote was unanimous.

PLUMBING INSPECTOR

Mr. Silvia motioned to appoint Norman Lussier, Plumbing Inspector. Mr. Eckenreiter seconded. Vote was unanimous. Term to expire May 31, 2005.


POLICE DEPARTMENT
