Mr. Manzone called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m.

Dr. Bowcock motioned to adjourn the Selectmen's Meeting when Town Meeting adjourns. Mr. Silvia seconded. Vote was unanimous.


Dr. Bowcock motioned to allow the Board of Health to hire Attorney Blaire Bailey to represent the Board of Health regarding on-going litigation for property at 62 Balsam Street. Mr. Silvia seconded. Vote was unanimous.

Dr. Bowcock motioned to take under advisement the memo from the Shellfish Constable, regarding a Shellfish Advisory Committee, and to refer to a committee to be formed at a later date. Mr. Silvia seconded. Vote was unanimous.

Dr. Bowcock motioned to refer the letter from the Veterans' Agent, requesting fees for shellfish licenses and ramp stickers be waived for any veteran that is 100% disabled to a committee, yet to be determined, and to have the committee report back to the Selectmen. Mr. Silvia seconded. Vote was unanimous.

Dr. Bowcock motioned to recommend indefinite postponement for Article 2 on the Special Town Meeting Warrant, Funding Labor Contracts, section 4. Highway Division, section 5. Sewer Department and section 6. Water Division. Mr. Silvia seconded. It was so voted. Mr. Manzone abstained.
