The site will be eventually taken off the Superfund List. Because of the success of this project, it will be used as a model for other Superfund Projects.


The Board offered their condolences to Bernice Alves and her family. Bernice's father passed away last week.

BUZZARDS BAY COALITION

Ben Bryant from the Buzzards Bay Coalition made a presentation on Oil Spill Response Plans for Buzzards Bay Coastal Areas. As a follow up to the Bouchard Oil Spill, the Department of Environmental Protection is providing funding for the Plan that is expected to be published in the spring of 2008. Topics addressed by Mr. Bryant included the history of oil spills in Buzzards Bay, State and Federal programs to prevent spills, response measures to be used during an oil spill and the Buzzards Bay Geographic Oil Spill Response Plan. Responsibilities of the Federal, State and local Governments were also discussed. A brief discussion followed.

At 7:50 p.m., Mr. Silvia motioned to adjourn. Dr. Bowcock seconded. Vote was unanimous.
