2016 Mooring Application Guidelines

All Moorings in the Town of Fairhaven, MA must be registered yearly via an application process available at the Office of the Selectmen.

During regular business hours

8:30 am – 4:30 pm M-F

Applications for new or existing moorings may be obtained at the Selectman's Office

ALL APPLICATIONS SHALL BE FILLED OUT COMPLETELY BY THE OWNER. REFERENCE TO PREVIOUS APPLICATIONS ARE NOT PERMITTED.

NAME OF VESSEL AND LOCATION MUST BE FILLED OUT TO GET STICKER.

Applicants shall declare their mooring an existing or new

Definition

(An existing mooring is a mooring that has been in place at during the previous season and was used during the previous season. Mooring not used last year, are considered new mooring sites and will require the approval of the Harbormaster before a sticker is issued.)

Selectman's office shall denote new or existing on application.

Applicants shall fill out application with only the Lat. & Long missing if not known. However we urge applicants to provide them if possible. General location is a **must** and if not provided they will be denied a sticker.

EXISTING Mooring applications when turned in COMPLETED the Selectman's Office will provide the applicant with a numbered Mooring Sticker. The sticker number will be put on the application. Then that application shall be forwarded to the Harbormaster via his mail box.

The selectman's Office will instruct the applicant to affix the sticker to their mooring ball above the water line.

NEW MOORING applications again require the applicant to fill out the form with desired mooring location(s), and all other information requested. The Selectman's Office will denote new on the application and then inform the applicant that their application will be sent to the Harbormaster for approval. The Harbormaster will then make a determination.

Stickers will only be given to existing moorings and new moorings that have been approved.

Information gathered on applications may be shared with The Coalition to Save buzzards Bay
