



Fairhaven Board of Selectmen

August 29, 2016 Meeting Minutes

Present: Select Board Chairman Charles K. Murphy, Sr., Vice Chairman Robert J. Espindola, and Clerk Daniel Freitas; and Administrative Assistant Anne O'Brien.

Mr. Murphy called the meeting to order in the Town Hall Banquet Room at 6:34 p.m. The meeting was audio recorded by the Selectmen's Office and video recorded by the Government Access channel.

CLARK H. REES

Mr. Murphy called for a moment of silence for Clark H. Rees, Mark Rees' father, who passed away the week prior. Mr. Rees was attending his father's services and unable to attend the meeting.

POLL WORKERS

The Board reviewed the anticipated listing of poll workers for the September 8, 2016 State Primary. See Attachment A. Mr. Espindola motioned to approve the listing of poll workers as outlined in Attachment A. Mr. Freitas seconded. Vote was unanimous. (3-0).

UNITED WAY FUNDRAISER KICK-OFF – DATE CHANGE

The Board reviewed a date change for the previously approved use of Town Hall auditorium for the United Way on September 15, 2016. The United Way requested to change the approval date to September 14, 2016, along with the associated one-day beer and wine license. Mr. Espindola motioned to approve the date change, and associated beer and wine license. Mr. Freitas seconded. Vote was unanimous. (3-0).

KENNEDY-DONOVAN FUNDRAISERS

The Board reviewed an application for a one-day, all alcohol license for a Kennedy-Donovan fundraiser at Down the Hatch on September 10, 2016, and a related waiver of all parking fees for the entire day at Hoppy's Landing on September 10. Mr. Espindola motioned to approve the request for the one-day all-alcohol license for Down the Hatch and the related parking waiver request for September 10. Mr. Freitas seconded. Vote was unanimous. (3-0).

the request for the one-day all-alcohol license for Bayside Lounge for September 17. Mr. Freitas seconded. Vote was unanimous. (3-0).

The Board reviewed a request from Carol-Ann Days-Merrill to hold the annual Turkey Trot on November 24, 2016. Mr. Espindola motioned to approve. Mr. Freitas seconded. Vote was unanimous. (3-0).
