Wendy gave a general explanation: property taxes, state aid, local receipts proposed at what was predicted. These are conservative estimates. Each line individually reviewed and estimates based on what we know.

Expenses: Departments entered their need/want. Angeline Ellison, the new Town Administrator cut all new positions until she can have to time to review. Each department was reviewed compared to prior year. Departments agreed with cuts. Cuts in salary lines for new positions to be revisited later in the year.

Wendy reported the balance in reserve funds will be \$35,594 after transfers tonight.
