- A translation of a community's values into specific actions
- NOT a zoning ordinance or regulation
- Meant to cover a 15 25 year time horizon






Snapshot of Fairhaven – Land Use











Land Use Change, 1985 - 2005

- Significant decrease in agricultural land and open undeveloped land
- Relatively steady residential growth, particularly in northwestern areas of town
- Establishment of commercial corridor along Route 6 and expansion along Alden Road
- Significant increase in natural vegetated area due to succession of inactive agricultural and open undeveloped land, and more detailed delineation of inland wetlands







Snapshot of Fairhaven – Land Use

Preliminary findings:

- Established commercial corridor along Route 6 with high vacancies
- Single family residential land dominates existing land use in Town
- Nearly half of Town zoned for Rural Residence Districts, defining the rural character of Town
- Zoning bylaw adopted 1966, outdated and lacks essential provisions to regulate and promote growth, e.g. business uses within industrial zones, smaller neighborhood commercial cores, etc.
- Most of the Town's remaining agricultural land located in East Fairhaven and part of the Neck
- Approximately 1,669 acres of land in town permanently protected for conservation, agriculture, recreation, and water resource protection













Population Change, 1970 - 2015



Population Change Projection, 2000-2030





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




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



Homes without mortgage




Gross Rent

Snapshot of Fairhaven – Housing

Preliminary findings:

- The Town has an relatively aged housing stock with predominately single families units
- Trend of aging population indicates more housing options for seniors
- Greater housing diversity is needed, particularly rental and condo units
- While overall household income is on the rise, affordability is still a challenge with nearly half of the town's rental households and a third of the owner-occupied households are cost-burdened

Between 2010 and 2015, Fairhaven experienced significant employment growth in the Health Care and Social Assistance industry sector.

Snapshot of Fairhaven – Economic Development

- Preliminary Findings:
 - Healthcare and Social Assistance fueling the most job growth in Fairhaven.
 - General concern around rising vacancy in big-box shopping centers (i.e. Kmart, Shaw's, Sears). Strategy required to retain service related jobs and ensure strength of the Route 6 corridor.
 - Opportunity for the Town to encourage mixed use development, on key redevelopment parcels.
 - Current business regulations and programs can be enhanced to continue to support the growth of small businesses.
 - The Town's housing stock appears to lack sufficient rental and condo product. There is an opportunity to add more multifamily units to provide affordable housing for multiple market audiences.



- Building was constructed and gifted to the Town by the Henry Rogers in 1892
- Addition to the old structure in 1968
- 12 Staff Members
- 19 member Board of Trustees



Council on Aging

- 17 paid staff and 85 volunteers
- Over 1700 elders served in 2016
- Offers advocacy, professional (legal, financial, etc.), support (social, transportation, etc.), and wellness (health screening, fitness, etc.) services
- Over-capacity/inadequate space: currently shares spaces with Recreation Department



Snapshot of Fairhaven – Transportation

Functional Classification

- Business Districts well served by higher order roadways (Arterials & Collectors)
- Harbor-based Industrial Districts served primarily by local roadways
- On average Fairhaven residents drive between 50 & 75 miles per day with a round-trip commute between 20 & 25 miles
- 75% of residents work in 6 municipalities (New Bedford, Fairhaven, Dartmouth, Fall River, Taunton & Acushnet)







Snapshot of Fairhaven – Transportation

Sidewalks & Bicycle Facilities

- No on-road bicycle facilities
- Poor pedestrian connectivity beyond Main Street corridor
- Limited pedestrian connections between residential and Route 6 retail/business areas
- Majority of sidewalks do not meet current ADA standards (narrow walking width, utility poles in the middle of the walk, limited marked crossings)







Snapshot of Fairhaven – Transportation

- Crashes
 - 9 High Crash Clusters within the Town (6 located along MassDOTcontrolled roadways)
 - 5 fatal crashes between 2012 and 2014 (3 pedestrian fatalities)
 - 78% of all crashes occurred on 7 roadways (Adams St, Alden Rd, Bridge St, Howland St, Route 6, Main St, Sconticut Neck Rd)






Snapshot of Fairhaven –

Open Space, Recreation and Natural Resources

- 7,942 acres in total (12 square miles)
- 3,183 acres developed (as of 2013)
- 2,894 acres of natural land (as of 2013); this consists of forest, wetland, and water
- 1,529 acres of open land (as of 2013); this consists of agricultural areas, bare soil, and low vegetation
- 1,888 acres protected (as of 2013)










Snapshot of Fairhaven – Historic Resources






 - Includes yard/garden waste, which gets converted to loam for public use
 - SEMASS waste-to-energy plant (Rochester, MA)
 - Additional Activities Among Other Sustainability Categories
 - Green Fairhaven/Fairhaven Sustainability Committee
 - Fairhaven Famers Market (Buy Local)
 - Fairhaven Community Garden at 60 Sconticut Neck Road
 - Phoenix Bike Trail 4.5 miles (Healthy Community)



Snapshot of Fairhaven – Resiliency

- Coastal Erosion and Sea Level Rise
 - 29.4 miles of shoreline
 - Coastal properties facing increased exposure from SLR and storm events
 - Working waterfront is an important economic driver and defining element
- Coastal Storms and Flooding
 - Priority concerns
 - High probability of future events
 - Increased frequency and severity
 - Causeway to West Island
 - West Island Neighborhood
 - Cushman Park Area
 - Edgewater St at Little Bay

- Other Hazards (preliminary findings from 2017 Hazard Mitigation Plan)
 - Drought
 - Earthquake


