Walmart is providing Pfizer COVID-19 vaccinations in Fairhaven in partnership with the Fairhaven Health Department.

Insurance is not required and there is no cost to receive the vaccine.



Why should I get vaccinated?

Getting the COVID-19 vaccine not only helps protect you, but also those around you who are not yet eligible to get the vaccine or are extra-vulnerable. By doing so, you're performing an act of service for your community and freeing up health care resources for those in need with other health conditions.

Is the vaccine safe?

Yes! All available vaccines are both safe and effective especially in preventing hospitalization and death. Some vaccines require two doses and others are effective after one dose. If you have received a two dose vaccine, we will make sure you get scheduled to get the second dose to be fully protected. The COVID-19 vaccine cannot give you COVID-19.

How to receive a COVID-19 vaccine

The COVID-19 vaccine is available at no cost to you.* Your second vaccination dose will take place during a clinic on **June 5, from 10:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.** Anyone under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

This is a walk up clinic. No appointments are needed.

What do I bring to my appointment?

On the day of your vaccination, please bring your insurance card (**red, white, and blue card if over 65**) and prescription card **if you have one**. Please plan to stay on-site for at least 15 minutes after your shot while we monitor you for allergic reaction.
