ATTENTION ALL DOG OWNERS **2020 DOG LICENSES**

Dog licenses can be renewed by mail, online at www.fairhaven-ma.gov, or in person at the Town Clerk's Office. Every year you must submit a rabies certificate for verification.

TO OBTAIN OR RENEW A DOG LICENSE BY MAIL: Fill out this form and return it with a ****self addressed stamped envelope, a current copy of dog's rabies certificate and your check payable to: The Town of Fairhaven.** Mail to: **Town Clerk's Office, 40 Center Street, Fairhaven, MA 02719**

Evidence required: Rabies Vaccination Certificate showing the expiration date, spay or neuter certificate. All evidence will be returned to the dog owner.

****YOU MUST INCLUDE A SELF ADDRESSED STAMPED ENVELOPE TO RECEIVE YOUR 2020 LICENSE AND TAG.**

All 2019 dog licenses must be renewed by **December 31, 2020** or a \$15.00 late fee will be issued per dog. (Mass General Laws Chapter 40, Section 22F)

Dog fees are as follows: Males (M) \$15.00 Females (F) \$15.00
 Neutered (NM) \$10.00 Spayed (SF) \$10.00

All dogs 6 months or older must be licensed and tagged in the Town of Fairhaven (Chapter 87, Section 8)

IMPORTANT: There is a leash law in the Town of Fairhaven (Chapter 87 Section 1B)

"The animal is under immediate control of its owner or custodian on a leash or chain affixed to the collar or harness of the animal"

If a property has more than 3 dogs, a kennel license must be obtained through the Zoning Board of Appeals (Chapter 198-33B (7), under the Fairhaven Zoning By-Laws)
