#### **CURBSIDE RECYCLABLES COLLECTION**

## Residents can recycle the following at the curb:

**PAPER**-newspaper & inserts, cereal boxes, brochures/fliers, mail, magazines, catalogues, telephone books, 3' cardboard pieces (no shredded paper)

**PLASTICS**-Jugs & Bottles only

NO RIGID PLASTIC
NO STYROFOAM

**METAL**-food and beverage cans only **GLASS**-clear & colored glass bottles & jars

**NOT ACCEPTED AT CURB:** plastic bags, film bags, juice & milk packs, chemical containers, aerosol cans, broken glass, ceramics, dinnerware

**DO:** commingle paper, plastic, glass and metal containers in the bin. DO NOT BAG OR TIE RECYCLEABLES they cannot be separated from bag or string at recycling facility. No string-no plastic bags or film bags please they will get stuck in machinery.



PLACE AT CURBSIDE BY 7:00 AM ON THE DAY OF COLLECTION

Recycling bins are collected every other week on the same day as your trash collection.

Call the Board of Health for your schedule.

Residents can bring the following items to the Recycling center

- All of the recyclables collected curbside
- Scrap metal
- White goods (dryers, ovens, etc.)
- ❖ Used oil \$0.25 per gallon
- Tires (auto \$2, truck \$10, tractor \$30)
- Lead & acid batteries

- ❖ Oil filters \$1 each
- Freon items (refrig, AC) \$20 each
- Computers & TVs \$20 each
- Grass, leaves, yard waste
- Mercury containing items (fluorescent bulbs, thermometers, thermostats)

# Plastic bags, wrap and film recycling DO NOT RECYCLE THIS MATERIAL IN YOUR CURBSIDE BIN.

### Examples include:

- Retail, carryout, produce, newspaper bags, bread, and dry-cleaning bags (clean, dry and free of receipts and clothes hangers)
- Zip-top food storage bags (clean and dry)
- Plastic shipping envelopes (remove labels), bubble wrap and air pillows (deflate)
- Product wrap on cases of water/soda bottles, paper towels, napkins, disposable cups, bathroom tissue, diapers, and female sanitary products
- Furniture and electronic wrap
- Plastic cereal box liners (but if it tears like paper, do not include)
- Any film packaging or bag that has the How2Recycle Label shown at right
