The four asphalt tennis courts at Cushman Park are used extensively by the Fairhaven Tennis Association as well as the Fairhaven Pickleball Association who share the facilities. The courts were last had the cracks repaired and entirely resurfaced in July 2017, and in New England outdoor asphalt courts typically last only 5-6 years before the cracks that result from the snow and ice of the winter months take their toll on the surface.

The Fairhaven Tennis Association is willing to pledge \$10,000 towards a project which would involve a qualified contractor to first clean all of the asphalt surface of any grass and clean out all of the cracks. Next they would powerwash the entire surface. Next would be the removal of about 150 feet of previously applied crack repair fabric. Then the Riteway Crack System would be installed to fill in and then apply fiberglass mesh ove the cracks to stabilize them. Then a coat of resurfacer would be applied to the entire surface to assist in waterproofing the surface.

Lastly, two coats of Nova Combination paint will be applied, and then they will layout and stripe new tennis lines in white and new pickleball lines in royal blue.
