Good Evening,

This is email is in regards to the 16 lot subdivision off of Hiller Avenue and Timothy Street. We are reaching out to ask for a request of the exact distance between the Sewer Treatment Plant and the Turbines to the property lines of all proposed 16 lots within the subdivision.

It is unclear whether your Board or another Board of Fairhaven may have this information. If not, would it be possible to request this information from the developer at the next meeting on January 14, 2020? Also, if possible, could we please know the exact amount of clearing that would need to be done for the three proposed Storm Water drainage easements abutting properties on 3, 5, and 7 Teal Circle?

What we have not been able to express enough to this Board is the importance of the tree line buffer that abuts our properties, not the tree line closest to the two Turbines that was proposed to be left as a buffer for this project in past meetings. The clearing of the land closest to our properties will open a complete unimpeded impact to the Flicker, Noises, Debris, and Odors to our homes.

In forethought, we respectfully ask this Board for an allowance of erecting some type of immediate barrier approximately 100 plus feet high along effected borders of our properties, to replace what will be taken away. It will protect our homes from the extreme added impact we will be forced to live with when lots #71 and 71A begin to get cleared for this project or any future project. We know this is not normally allowed in the Town of Fairhaven, but the circumstances and situation surrounding this neighborhood deserves a resolution that might not normally be allowed by your Board.

Paul, please pass this email on to the rest of the Planning Board I could not find emails for, or emails listed were undeliverable on my end. I tried emailing Ann Richard and John Farrell, but received emails stating the email addresses were unknown. I could not find emails for the other members. I was able to get an email through to Wayne Hayward.
