Project Purpose:

The purpose of the project is to perform site improvements and protect the property and pre-1961 dwelling from future coastal storm damage.

Site Background:

The subject property is approximately 9,880 sq. ft. in size and is completely developed with a single family dwelling, detached garage, concrete driveway and manicured lawn areas throughout. The property is bordered easterly by Bayside Street, southerly by Bayberry Street (a paper street), westerly by Buzzards Bay and northerly by a developed residential house lot. The site is protected from Buzzards Bay by the existing stone/concrete seawall.

Wetland Resource Areas:

The entire site falls within Land Subject to Coastal Storm Flowage, Flood Zones VE (El. 20 & 23). The site contains Coastal Bank (top of concrete seawall). Coastal Beach between the face of the seawall and mean low water. The entire site falls within the 100 ft. Buffer Zone of the Top of Coastal Bank.

Project Description:

The Applicant proposes to remove and replace the existing concrete slab inside the garage and to remove and replace the existing concrete driveway within the same footprints. All concrete debris will be loaded into dump trucks or dumpsters for disposal at an appropriate offsite facility. The Applicant additionally proposes to construct a ground level composite patio and to extend the existing seawall to protect the property from additional storm damage. The seawall will consist of stone rip-rap set at a minimum slope of 1:1 with a majority set at 2:1. The landward side of said sloped wall will be supported by a 12" thick concrete wall, both of which will have a finished top elevation set at 8.2 to match the existing wall located westerly. The concrete wall will be fitted with a 24" high fence for wind protection. The patio will be constructed between the existing concrete pad below the house and the new concrete wall using composite type deck boards secured to a timber frame using stainless steel screws. The timber frame will be bolted to the concrete walls.

Compliance with the WPA:

The proposed work will be performed within Land Subject to Coastal Storm Flowage, Flood Zone VE (El. 20) and there are no Performance Standards for Land Subject to Coastal Storm Flowage. Additionally, the project site <u>does not</u> fall within an area mapped by the Natural Heritage & Endangered Species Program.



SCONTICUT NECK QUAD.


U.S.G.S. QUADRANGLE MAP

SCONTICUT NECK QUAD.


ESTIMATED HABITAT MAP


ASSESSORS MAP #42
