

# Fairhaven Sustainability Committee July 16, 2019 Meeting Minutes

#### MINUTES

- Ms. O'Brien motioned to approve the minutes of the May 21, 2019 meeting. Ms. Drumm seconded. Vote was unanimous. (4-0)
- Ms. O'Brien motioned to approve the minutes of the June 18, 2019 meeting. Ms. Drumm seconded. Vote was unanimous (4-0).

## LEADERSHIP RESTRUCTURE

The Chair offered to take agenda item #6, "Discussion and Vote to Restructure Leadership Positions", out of order. There were no objections to the change in agenda order.

Ms. O'Brien volunteered to serve as a recording secretary until another option could be identified, for a term not to exceed six months. Ms. Richard accepted the offer as a motion and seconded it. Vote was unanimous. (4-0).

## PLASTIC FREE JULY UPDATE

Ms. McClees updated the group to the activities of the Southcoast team on the Drawdown Plastic Free July campaign. At the time of the meeting, the Southcoast/Fairhaven team was ranked 36

out of 761 global teams. The outreach by the Sustainability Committee at the Saturday Huttleston Marketplace had been successful and well-received.

### SUSTAINABILITY CAFÉ

The group discussed ideas and potential subject matter for the upcoming "Sustainability Café". The café discussions will take place on the first Saturday of each month. Ms. McClees will reach out to the Harrop Center to see if there would be meeting space with a sink for the purpose of the café. Ms. Healy will collect ideas for a year's schedule of café topics.
